

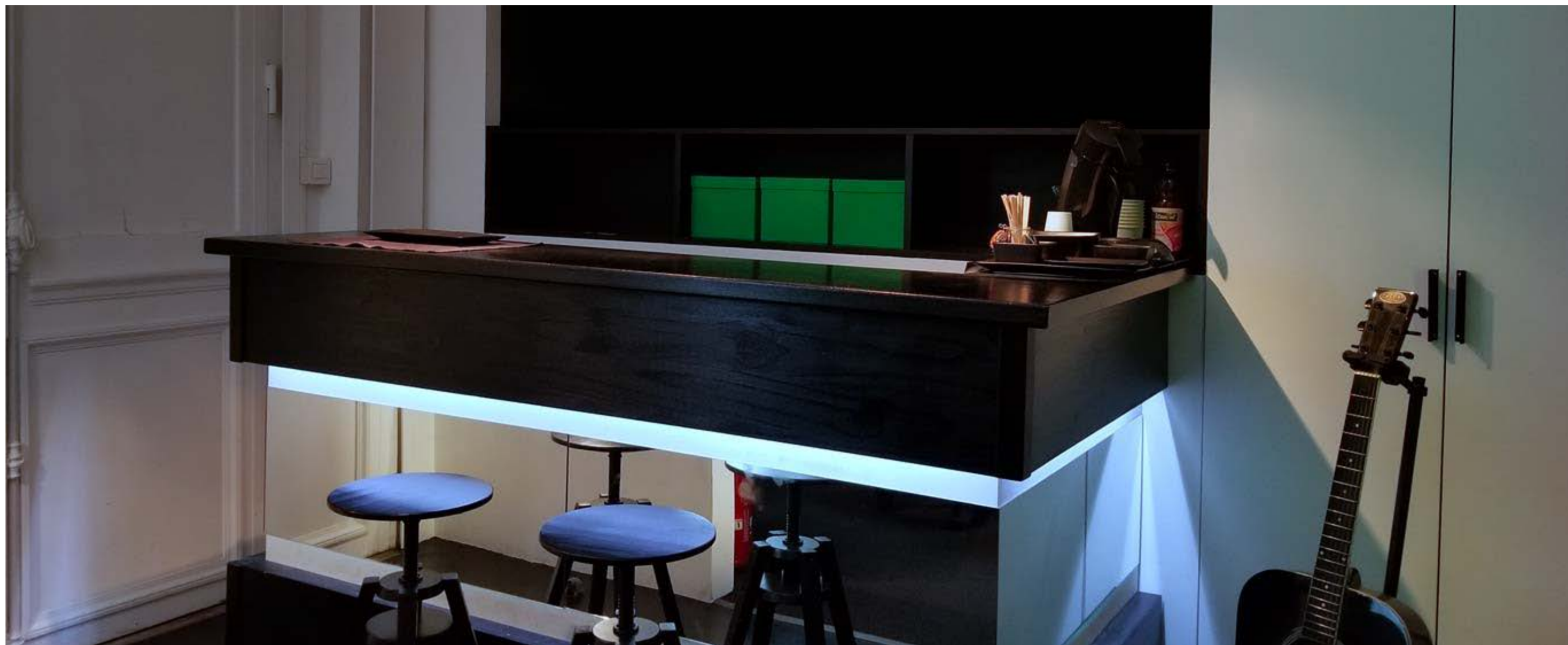

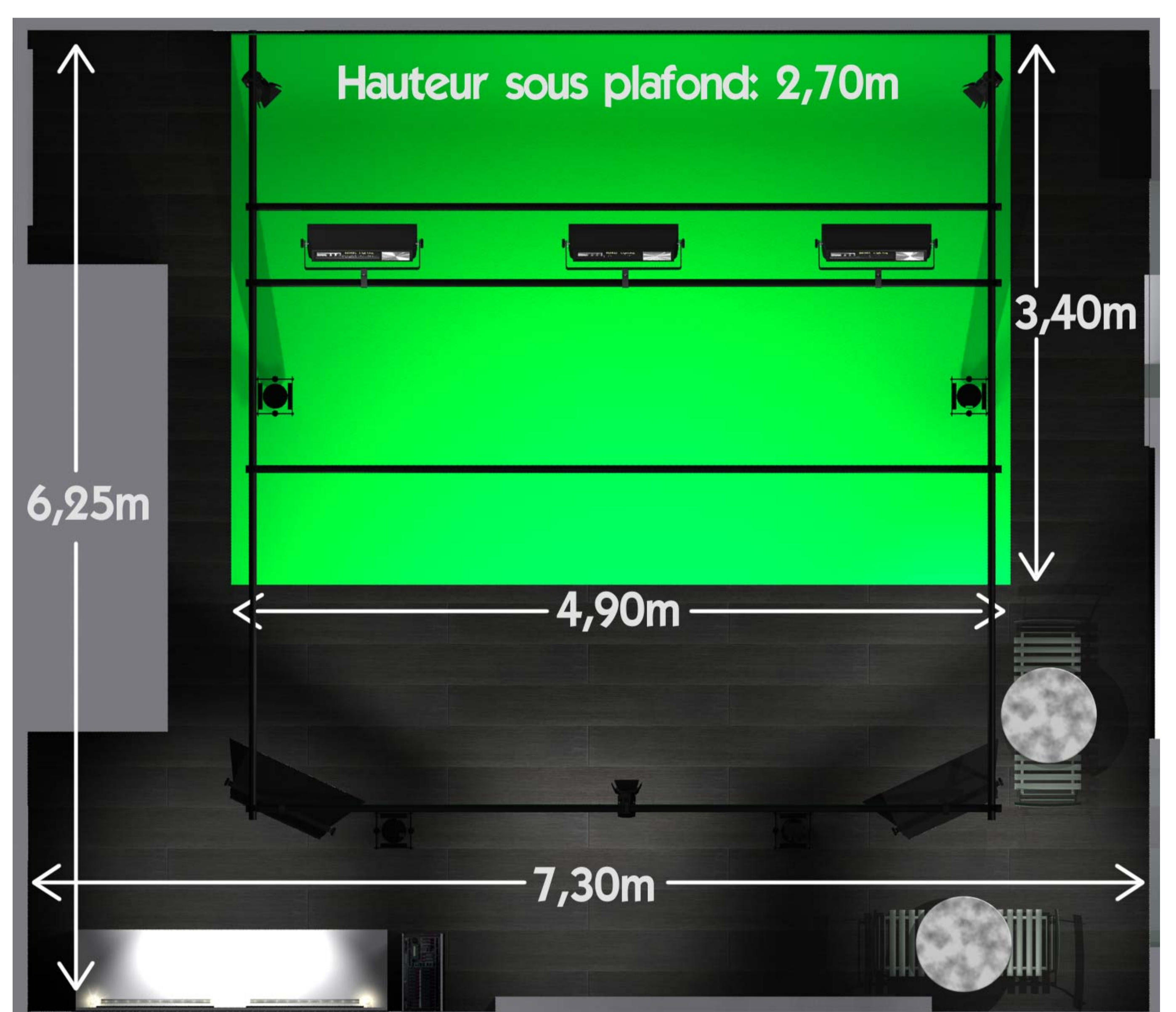
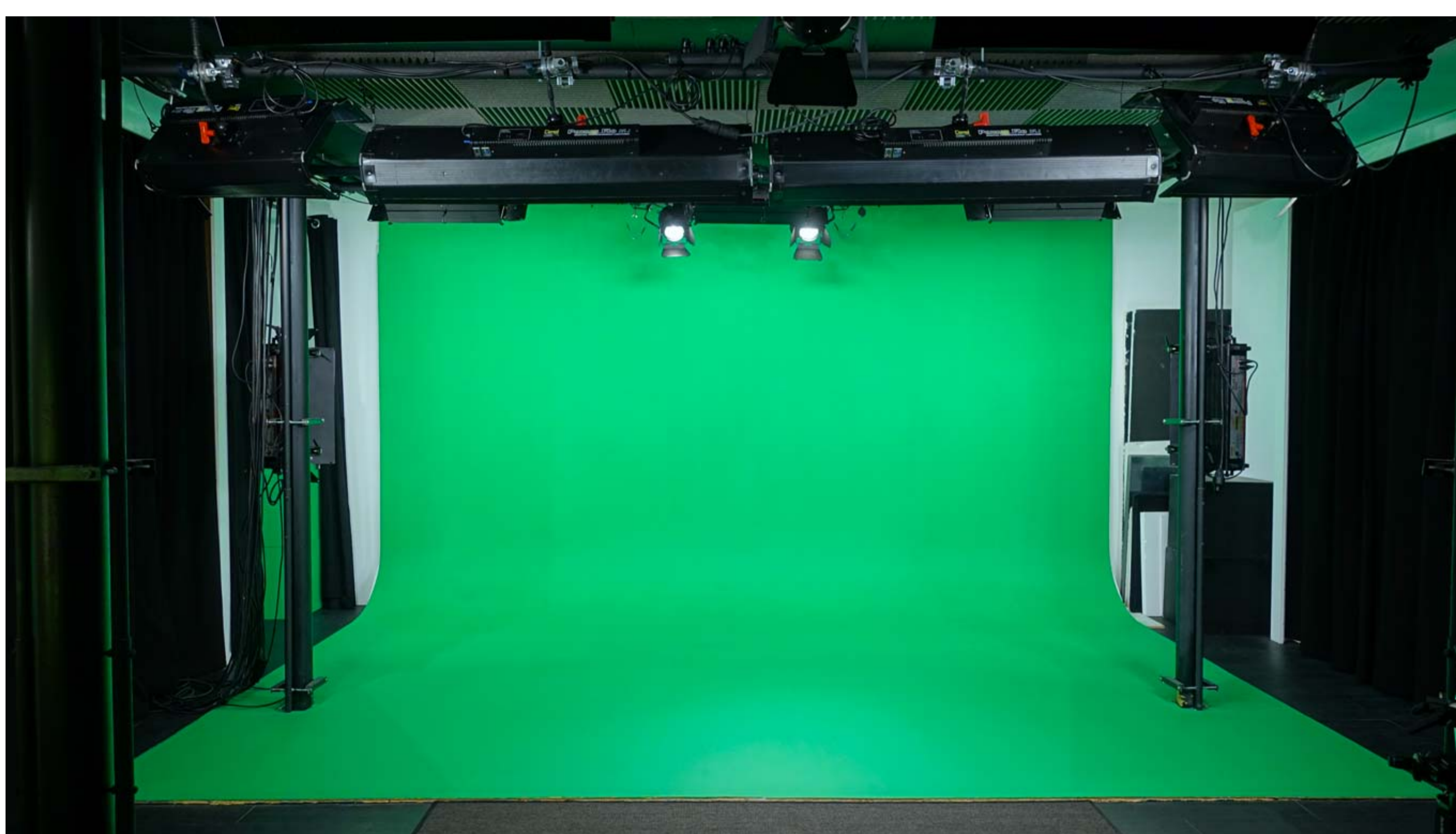


WELCOME

PRIME LOCATION

CONFIGURATIONS

The studio is adaptable to suit your production needs. Whether you require a black backdrop, a Colorama setup (white or other colors), or other configurations, you'll find several layout examples listed alongside.

DIMENSIONS & POWER SUPPLY

All studio dimensions are listed on the next page. The available power is distributed through a three-phase circuit, providing three 16A lines for a total of 10kW.

We can provide additional equipment for your production, including camera gear, extra lighting, and rigging. Need expert professionals? We've got you covered with cinematographers, stage managers, sound engineers, makeup artists, and more.

AROUND THE STUDIO

Forgot your SD cards? No worries FNAC is just a minute's walk away. Plus, you'll find plenty of restaurants nearby for your lunch break.

AVAILABILITY

The studio is available for 9 hours per full-day rental (8 working hours + 1 - hour lunch break) and 4 hours for half-day rentals. Additional hours are charged at 95 euros (excl. VAT) per hour. Rental includes full access to the studio and its pre-installed lighting setup. For smooth scheduling, note that the studio opens at 9 AM, unless otherwise arranged. To assist with your shoot, we provide a rolling cart with essential grip gear (clamps, magic arms, crocodile clips, cinefoil, etc.).

LIGHTING SETUP

Lighting is controlled via a DMX console and includes:

- 2 Dixel fluorescent facial lights (6 tubes, 55W each)
- Cyclorama background lighting: 3 Dixel fluorescent lights (2 tubes, 55W each)
- 2 Fresnel 300W backlights
- 1 Fresnel 300W front light
- 2 Manda 800W side lights
- Spare equipment: 1 Manda 800W & 1 Fresnel 500W
- All studio lighting is calibrated to tungsten (3200°K) for consistent color balance.
